

Background

On June 27, 2024, Governor Whitmer and the Michigan Legislature passed the **Fiscal Year 2025** budget which includes the Michigan Community College Guarantee.



The Guarantee covers in-district tuition for a skilled trades certificate or associate degree, for recent high school graduates at their local community college. Those who do not have a community college within their county (do not pay taxes to support a community college) must pay the out-of-county difference in tuition.

The Guarantee is part of the Michigan Achievement Scholarship (MAS). It replaces the MAS for Community Colleges.

The Governor signed the budget in July 2024.



- 2023 Grads enroll by August 26, 2024
- 2024 Grads must enroll by Fall 2025
- Skilled Trades Certificate or Degree
- Online or In-Person
- Free in-district tuition, contact hours, and mandatory fees
- Students who qualify for the Federal Pell Grant can receive an added \$1,000 to help cover added costs like books & supplies
- No income or high school GPA requirements
- Renewable annually

Eligibility

- Complete the FAFSA
- Be a Michigan resident since July 1 of the previous calendar year. [Dependent students' your parent(s) must also be a Michigan resident since July 1 of the previous calendar year (FAFSA)]
- Earn a high school diploma, certificate of completion, or high school equivalency certificate, from a Michigan high school in 2023 or after
- Enroll in college full-time, within 15 months of graduation
- Students are not eligible if they're in default on a federal student loan





WITH A SKILLED TRADES CERTIFICATE OR DEGREE

As a 2023 or 2024 high school graduate, you are eligible for reduced tuition at Muskegon Community College. It doesn't matter what your parents' income is, or what your GPA was in high school. Students who qualify for the Federal Pell Grant can receive an added \$1,000 to help cover added costs like books and supplies. To qualify for the Michigan Community College Guarantee, you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid form at fafsa.gov and attend a community college in Michigan full-time.

2023 graduates must enroll by August 26, 2024. **2024 graduates** must enroll by Fall 2025.
